

**CITY OF PROPHETSTOWN, ILLINOIS
CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 20, 2017**

I. CALL TO ORDER: A regular meeting of the Prophetstown City Council was held at City Hall in Prophetstown, Illinois on June 20, 2017. The meeting convened at 7:05 p.m., Mayor Steve Swanson, presiding.

III. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Mayor Swanson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

IV. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION:

- 1. Consideration and possible action: to approve Ordinance #816 – An Ordinance Appropriating Necessary Sums for the 2017-18 Fiscal Year.**

MOTION: Approval by the council to accept the 2017-2018 budget.
MOTION MOVED BY L. SWANSON, SECONDED BY DRENNEN.
COUNCIL CONCURRED. MOTION CARRIED.

- 2. Consideration and possible action: to approve the passing of the Prophetstown Planning Commission Resolution #2017-0620 – Report and Recommendation of Planning Commission to City Council Regarding Application by the Cal Williams Trust to Rezone Property at 605 Grove Street from R1 Residential to B1 Retail Business District.**

Mayor Swanson stated that nine members were present at the zoning commission meeting.

Mayor Swanson stated that the vote was unanimous to rezone the property.

3. Consideration and possible action: to approve Ordinance #817 (2017-0621) – Establishing the Annual Prevailing Wages Rate.

MOTION: Approval by the council of Ordinance #817 (2017-0621).

COUNCIL CONCURRED. MOTION CARRIED.

4. Consideration and possible action: to amend Ordinance #815 – An Ordinance Amending Title IX of the City Code of the City of Prophetstown, Illinois, by the Addition of a New Chapter 9 Regulating the Business and Licensure of Peddlers of Food, Beverages, and Other Goods.

Mayor Swanson stated that he thought amendments need to be made to the ordinance.

Mayor Swanson's suggested amendments, including, but not limited to:

- 1.) Changing the permit fee from \$50.00 to \$100.00.
- 2.) Limit the amount of vendors to a total quantity of 2, the permits would be first come, first served.
- 3.) The vendor(s) could only operate in the business district, which includes the area between 2nd Street and 6th Street. The vendors would need to operate a minimum of 100-150 feet away from Route 78.
- 4.) Thicksten's Popcorn stand and Shaw's Grocery Store would be exempt from the special events section of the ordinance; they would be able to continue to sell their goods during special events/holidays.

The council agreed to table further discussion on the matter until the July 11, 2017 regular city council meeting.
